Part-Time Museum Guide The President Woodrow Wilson House

The President Woodrow Wilson House is seeking part-time museum guides to lead daily tours and assist with weekend and evening events. Museum guides perform in all areas of visitor services, including leading public tours of the historic house museum, assisting with events and programs, and operating the museum shop. The museum guide should be a flexible and dynamic worker who is excited to join a small team dedicated to preserving and sharing American history and shaping a new, more inclusive interpretation.

This is a part-time position that requires weekends and evening events. The hourly rate is \$14.25 per hour. Candidates should demonstrate their exceptional visitor service and public speaking skills, as well as their willingness to learn about the topics presented and to apply their unique approach to foster discussion and experiential learning for visitors. Candidates with background or experience in inclusive histories or historic sites, especially those focused in African-American history and/or women's history, are encouraged to apply. The selected candidate will be committed to understanding and telling a full representation of history, and especially the inclusive stories and histories of the Wilson era.

The President Woodrow Wilson House is the home to which President and Mrs. Wilson retired from the White House in 1921. The museum promotes a greater awareness of Wilson's public and private life and his complicated place in American history. Through guided tours, exhibits, and educational programs, Museum guides provide a forum for historical discussion and learning, inspiring guests to connect with President Wilson's life and legacy.

The President Woodrow Wilson House is a property of the National Trust for Historic Preservation, a privately funded, non-profit corporation, helping people protect, enhance and enjoy the places that matter to them.
